### **Which Project File Do I use?:**

- If you are running AECC 2018-2020 (Use version 2018)
- If you are running AECC 2014-2017 (Use version 2014)
- If you are running AECC CC (Use version CC)

### **Software requirements:**

- Must be running After Effects CC (12.0) or newer.
- Must have VideoCopilot Element 3D version 2.0 or higher (NOT INCLUDED) You can purchase this plugin at [www.videocopilot.net](http://www.videocopilot.net)

Below are instructions for installing the pseudo effect required for this After Effects template to operate properly.

### **Mac Install:**

- 1) Locate After Effects Application  
/Applications/Adobe After Effects <version>
- 2) Right click on application and choose "Show Package Contents"
- 3) Navigate to:  
/Contents/Resources/PresetsEffects.xml
- 4) Duplicate that file and name it "PresetsEffectsBACKUP.xml"
- 5) Open the original file called "PresetsEffects.xml" in TextEdit
- 6) Scroll all the way down to the very bottom of the document.
- 7) Now open the included "CGEyes\_Plugin\_v2.txt" file in TextEdit
- 8) Select ALL of the text and copy it via "COMMAND + C" keyboard shortcut.
- 9) Now locate the last two lines in the "PresetsEffects.xml" document. It will say...

- 10) Enter a carriage return after the "</Effect>" line. The one with NO "s".

- 11) Now paste the text you copied in step 8 on the new line.

- 12) Before saving the "PresetsEffects.xml" file, verify that the very last line of the document says....

- 13) Save and close the "PresetsEffects.xml" file.
- 14) Pseudo effect is now installed, launch After Effects. Relaunch After Effects if it is already open.

## PC Install:

- 1) Locate PresetEffects.xml file  
C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe After Effects <version>\Support Files\PresetEffects.xml
- 2) Duplicate that file and name it "PresetEffectsBACKUP.xml"
- 3) Open the original file called "PresetEffects.xml" in a simple text editor.
- 4) Scroll all the way down to the very bottom of the document.
- 5) Now open the included "CGEyes\_Plugin\_v2.txt" file in the same simple text editor.
- 6) Select ALL of the text and copy it.
- 7) Now locate the last two lines in the "PresetEffects.xml" document. It will say...

- 8) Enter a carriage return after the "</Effect>" line. The one with NO "s".
